Dear Parents/Carers,

With just one week to go until our Residential Trip to Kingswood, I wanted to give you a couple of reminders:

- The trip date is Wednesday 30th April Friday 2nd May.
- Children need to come to school in their own clothes (active clothes which will be comfortable to travel in).
- They will need to bring their suitcase into the main hall. They should have no phones/devices
 or electrics within their suitcases. Children should not bring any money.
- Children will go to class for the morning and have lunch in school before we leave. If they are having packed lunch, please put this into a carrier bag so it can be thrown away once finished.
- All children must bring a reusable water bottle with them.
- If you have not yet filled in a medical form, this must be completed as soon as possible and by Monday 28th April at the latest.
- All medicines need to be brought to the school office by Monday 28th at the very latest in
 either a named bag or box. If it is medicine that they need to take daily or on the morning of
 the trip, this can be brought in on the day.
- For any children that require travel sickness medicine, this must also be handed into the office and a medical form filled in.
- We are aiming to be picked up by the coach at 13:00-13:30. Parents are welcome to wave children off from the bus stop outside Strood Sports Centre on Watling Street.
- We should be back at school by usual end of school day time on Friday 2nd. However, this could change depending on traffic and we will update you as much as possible. With the coach parking at the bus stop outside Strood Sports Centre on Watling Street, children can be collected from here or from school as normal.
- Photos will be taken throughout the trip for children who have photo permission and shared with you via our X and Facebook accounts.
- During the trip, children will be in activity groups with children from All Faiths, as well as Gordon Children's Academy and Cedar Children's Academy – this is a good opportunity to mix with children within the local area and make new friends!
